COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY

July 22, 1997

BE IT REMEMBERED That the Fayette County Legislative Body met in regular session at the Courthouse in Somerville, Tennessee, on the 22nd day of July, 1997, same being the fourth Tuesday in said month.

Present and presiding the Honorable Jim Voss, also present, Dell T. Graham, County Clerk and the following County Commissioners: John W. Arnett, Charles D. Brewer, Sr., Odis Cox, Robert L. Crawford, Thomas H. Fowler, Willie L. German, Jr., Ronald R. Harris, William Hayslett, David Kelley, Alonzo Morman, Sr., David Morris, Claude D. Oglesby, Jr., Hollis O. Robison, J. M. Sullivan, Jr., Rhea "Skip" Taylor, Wayne Thomas, Gordon Tomlin, Myles Wilson and Allen Yancey, Jr.

With all members being present, the following proceedings were had and entered of record, to-wit:

Motion was made by Commissioner Kelley, seconded by Commissioner Oglesby, and unanimously carried by the Board approving the minutes of the June 1997 meeting.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wilson, seconded by Commissioner Morman, and unanimously carried by the Board appointing the following as Notaries Public: District 1: Charles Dudley Brewer, Sr., Roberta W. Parker; District 8: Deborah F. Craft, Bailey Houston; District 12: Milton E. Holt, Sr.; District 10: Joyce Hollingsworth; District 14: George David Blackburn.

Now before the Board was the election of a member to the School Board representing District 4. The floor was opened for nominations.

Commissioner Morris made motion nominating NADOLYN SHELTON.

Motion was made by Commissioner Robison placing DEBORAH HAILEY as a nominee for election.

Motion was then made by Commissioner German, seconded by Commissioner Taylor, and unanimously carried by the Board that the nominations cease.

Commissioner Robison then addressed the Board speaking in favor of Doborah Hailey.

Upon roll call, the following voted for SHELTON: Commissioners Arnett, Brewer, Cox, Harris, Hayslett, Morman, Morris, Oglesby, Taylor, Wilson and Yancey. (11)

Voting for HAILEY: Commissioners Crawford, Fowler, German, Kelley, Robison, Thomas, Tomlin. (7)

Thereupon Nadolyn Shelton was elected to serve on the Fayette County Board of Education until August 1998.

Motion was made by Commissioner Morris, seconded by Commissioner Robison, and unanimously carried by the Board appointing J. M. Sullivan, Jr. to the Zoning Appeals Board.

With the recommendation of the Education Committee, Commissioner Tomlin, with a second by Commissioner Oglesby, moved to appoint Jenny Sabatier and George Adams to the Library Board. Said motion was unanimously carried by the Board.

Having been reviewed by the Education Committee and presented with their recommendation, motion was made by Commissioner Oglesby, seconded by Commissioner Robison, and unanimously carried by the Board appointing Mr. and Mrs. J. G. Walker, Jr. to the Regional Library Board.

Barbra Parker, Trustee of Fayette County, reviewed the report of delinquent real and utility taxes for the year 1995. Motion was made by Commissioner Tomlin, seconded by Commissioner Fowler and unanimously carried by the Board accepting said report.

The report of errors and double assessments for the year 1995 was then reviewed by Barbra Parker. Motion was made by Commissioner Robison, seconded by Commissioner Crawford, and unanimously carried by the Board accepting the report as presented.

Erwin Kee reported orally for the Board of Public Works.

Report was called for from the Board of Education, but none available.

Reports from the Ambulance Service, Fayette County Commission on Aging, Development Office, General Sessions Court, Sheriff's Department, Juvenile Court, Emergency Management, Rabies Control, County Development Committee, Education Committee, Health & Welfare Committee, Criminal Justice & Public Safety Committee, Personnel Committee and the Budget Committee were called for, but none presented.

Thereupon, said meeting adjourned.
