

FAYETTE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY

March 28, 2000

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**BE IT REMEMBERED** That the Fayette County Legislative Body met in regular session at the Courthouse in Somerville, Tennessee, on the 28th day of March, 2000.

Present and presiding the Honorable Jim Voss. Also present, Dell T. Graham, County Clerk and the following County Commissioners: John W. Arnett, Floyd Bonner, Charles Dudley Brewer, Sr., Joe B. Burnette, Jr., Odis Cox, Carl Doyle, Ronnie Graves, Willie German, Ronnie Harris, David Kelley, Sylvester Logan, Calvin Moore, Alonzo Morman, Jr., David Morris, John S. Sullivan, Sr., Rhea "Skip" Taylor, Gordon M. Tomlin and Myles Wilson. (18)

With a quorum being present, the following proceedings were had and entered of record, to-wit:

Motion was made by Commissioner Kelley, seconded by Commissioner Graves and unanimously carried by the Board approving the minutes of the February 2000 meeting.

Motion was made by Commissioner Tomlin, seconded by Commissioner Morman, and unanimously carried by the Board appointing the following to the Airport Board: Hollis Robison, Dr. Sam Hardison, Jack Dawson, John Cima and Charles Haddad.

Motion was made by Commissioner Burnette, seconded by Commissioner Doyle, and unanimously carried by the Board appointing the following as Notaries Public: Gladys Billings, Gloria G. Douglas, Emily Joyce Douglass, Patricia D. Medford, Theresa M. Meyer, Delores Dale Provow, Rebecca S. Rogers, Tammy L. Sherman.

Reports from the Mayor's Office, Board of Public Works and Board of Education were called for, but none presented.

Commissioner Morris reported for the County Development Committee. Motion was made by him to approve the road work at the City of Piperton with that city reimbursing the county as recommended by the Public Works Department. Said motion was seconded by Commissioner Logan and unanimously approved by the Board.

As recommended by the County Development Committee, motion was made by Commissioner Morris, seconded by Commissioner Arnett, and unanimously carried by the Board that the current city boundaries remain as is for three years.

Commissioner Morris then advised that with the opinion of the County Attorney that the Board of Public Works would surface Brockford Road at Hickory Withe.

Reports were called for from the Education Committee, Criminal Justice/ Public Safety and the Health & Welfare Committee, but none presented.

Commissioner Brewer presented the opinion of the County Attorney in the Robert Liles insurance case, advising that Fayette County is not responsible in this matter. Discussion followed.

As recommended by the County Development Committee to the Budget Committee, and so approved by them, motion was made by Commissioner Harris, seconded by Commissioner Morris, and unanimously carried by the Board setting a Building Inspection Fee for cities at 65% of the permit fee.

Motion was made by Commissioner Harris, seconded by Commissioner Brewer and unanimously carried by the Board establishing a County Public Records Commission. Members to this Commission will be appointed at a later date.

Motion was then made by Commissioner Harris, seconded by Commissioner Arnett and unanimously carried by the Board approving the following Resolution amending General Fund #101:
