FAYETTE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY

August 26, 2003

BE IT REMEMBERED That the Fayette County Legislative Body met in regular session at the Courthouse in Somerville, Tennessee, on the 26th day of August, 2003.

Present and presiding, Chairman Rhea Taylor, Also present, Dell T. Graham, County Clerk, and the following County Commissioners: Joann C. Allen, Steve Anderson, Joe B. Burnette, Jr., Christopher L. Campbell, Bob Doll, Lee "Sissy" Dowdle, John F. Dowdy, Thomas Howell Fowler, Willie German, Jr., Ronnie Graves, Ronnie Harris, Myles Leifer, David H. Lillard, Sr., Sylvester Logan, George McCloud, Claude D. Oglesby, Jr., Richard D. Vaughan, Myles Wilson, Allen Yancey, Jr.

With all members being present, the following proceedings were had and entered of record, to-wit:

Chairman Taylor opened the floor for the public to address items not on the Agenda. Addressing the Board were Rick Nuber, Jim Hilliard, Rob Martin and Commissioner Anderson

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan, seconded by Commissioner Leifer and unanimously carried by the Board to advise the YMCA of the support of this Board of Commissioners for location in Fayette County.

The next matter before the Board was the approval of minutes of the June and July meetings of this Board. Before approval of the June 2003 minutes, Commissioner Lillard asked for ratification of the **Adequate Facilities Tax**. Commissioner Dowdle asked that no action be taken on this item until next month. Discussion followed. Motion was then made by Commissioner Harris, seconded by Commissioner Wilson to approve the June minutes. Upon roll call vote, the following voted "Yes": Commissioners Burnette, Dowdy, Harris, Leifer, Oglesby, Vaughan and Wilson. (7)

Voting "No": Commissioners Allen, Anderson, Campbell, Doll, Dowdle, Fowler, German, Graves, Lillard, Logan, McCloud and Yancey. (12)  
Motion to approve the June 2003 minutes failed.

Motion was then made by Commissioner McCloud, seconded by Commissioner Leifer and unanimously carried by the Board approving the minutes of the July 2003 meeting of this Board.

At this time the floor was opened to the public for comments regarding a Local Law Enforcement Block Grant of which the County would receive \$27,000,00. No comments were offered; the floor was closed to the public.

Motion was made by Commissioner Dowdy, seconded by Commissioner Logan and unanimously carried by the Board approving the following as **Notaries Public**: Kimberly Crutcher, Connie Parks Ferge, Linda L. Jones, Cynthia O. Lacy, Carolyn G. Rhea, Doug Simpson, Susan A. Simpson and Michael L. Wainscott.

Motion was made by Commissioner Harris, seconded by Commissioner Leifer and unanimously carried by the Board for future notary applications to be submitted on the state approved form.

**Financial Report** from the Register of Deeds and an **Ambulance Report** were filed.

Chairman Taylor reported for the Mayor's Office.

The **Trustee's Report of Errors and Double Assessments** was filed.

Commissioner Wilson reported for the Board of Education.

The monthly report from the Board of Public Works was filed.

Written reports from the Sheriff's Department and Juvenile Court were filed.

Commissioner Logan reported for the **Development Committee**. He presented their recommendation for approval of the **Airport Contract** with submitted charges. Discussion followed. Motion was made by Commissioner Campbell, seconded by Commissioner McCloud and unanimously carried by the Board directing this matter back to the Development Committee.

Commissioner Logan then presented the recommendation of the Development Committee to approve a new subdivision road in Macon Ridge Subdivision, subject to approval by the Public works Department. Public Works did not recommend approval of this, pending right-of-way rights. Motion was then made by Commissioner Logan, seconded by Commissioner Leifer and unanimously carried by the Board to table action on this matter.

Commissioner Graves reported for the **Criminal Justice & Public Safety Committee** presenting to the Budget Committee their recommendation to approve a **Local Law Enforcement Block Grant**. Motion was made by Commissioner Dowdle, seconded by Commissioner Burnette to approve the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant. Motion was declared out of order until approved by the Budget Committee.

The Public Safety Committee also recommended for approval by the Commission **Barge, Waggoner, Sumner & Cannon, Inc.** as architects for the **Justice Complex**. Motion was made by Commissioner Leifer, seconded by Commissioner Burnette to approve this recommendation. Upon Roll Call Vote, the following voted "Yes": Commissioners Anderson, Burnette, Campbell, Dowdle, Dowdy, Fowler, German, Harris, Leifer, Oglesby, Vaughan, Wilson and Yancey. (13)

Voting "No": Commissioners Allen, Doll, Graves, Lillard, Logan,  
McCloud. (6)

Said motion carried.

Report from the Personnel Committee was called for, but none presented.

Report of the Education Committee was called for and would be addressed  
under the Budget Committee report.

Commissioner German reviewed the meeting of the Health & Welfare  
Committee with recommendations to be addressed by the Budget Committee.

Commissioner Doll, Chairman of the **Budget Committee**, reviewed a contract  
for **jail telephone services** as approved by that committee. Motion was made by  
Commissioner Doll, seconded by Commissioner Leifer and unanimously carried by the  
Board approving same.

Motion was made by Commissioner Doll, seconded by Commissioner Graves,  
and unanimously carried by the Board approving a **Local Law Enforcement Block Grant**  
as recommended by the Budget Committee.

Commissioner Doll addressed approval of an RDA Litter Grant by the  
Budget Committee which would be included with 2003/04 budget.

Chairman Taylor then reviewed sites being considered for location of the  
Justice Complex. Motion was made by Commissioner Campbell, seconded by Commissioner  
Vaughan to accept the site on Highway 64W for location of the Justice Complex. The  
following Roll Call Vote was taken. Voting "Yes": Commissioners Allen, Burnette,  
Campbell, Doll, Dowdle, Dowdy, German, Graves, Harris, Leifer, McCloud, Oglesby,  
Vaughan, Wilson and Yancey. (15)

Voting "No": Commissioners Anderson, Fowler and Lillard.

Passing: Commissioner Logan.

Said motion carried.

With no other matters to be brought before this Board, said meeting  
adjourned.
