FAYETTE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY

BE IT REMEMBERED that the Fayette County Legislative Body Met in special session at the Bill G. Kelley Justice Complex in Somerville, Tennessee, on the 10th day of April, 2008. With a quorum being present the following proceedings were had and entered of record, to wit:

The first item on the agenda was a meeting of the Commissioners and the County Attorney.

After the meeting, the Commissioners re-assembled and Commissioner Anderson moved that the effective date of any sprinkler ordinance be no sooner than July 1, 2008 and furthermore, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the current sprinkler ordinance, no sprinkler ordinance shall be enforced or effective until a further vote of the County Commission. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Cook, and passed unanimously by the Board.

Commissioner Oglesby moved for adjournment, and the motion was seconded by Commissioner Dowdy, and approved by the Board.
