BE IT REMEMBERED that the Fayette County Legislative Body met in a special called session at the Bill G. Kelley Criminal Justice Complex in Somerville Tennessee, on the 28th day of October, 2010. Present and presiding was Chairman Rhea Taylor. Also present were Rose G. Posey, Administrative Assistant to the County Clerk, Tom Whitaker, Deputy Sheriff, and the following County Commissioners: Ed Allen, Steve Anderson, Charles Brewer, Lee "Sissy" Dowdle, Ronald Harris, Reggie Howard, Tom Karcher, Sylvester Logan, Claude Oglesby, Steve Reeves, Raymond Seals, Myles Wilson, and Larry Watkins.

Absent were the following: Joann Allen, Odis Cox, Willie German, Bill Kelley, Terry Leggett, and David Lillard. With a quorum being present the meeting from October 26, 2010, was reconvened.

This meeting was called to discuss and vote on health insurance for County employees. The Mayor recommended that this insurance not be subscribed to as it would not in its present form save the County the proposed amount of money which was the reason for consideration in the first place. He further stated that in some instances the amount each employee would pay would be between \$30 and \$40 too little a month. He stated that the matter would be sent back to Health and Welfare for further study before acceptance.

With no further business before the Board, Commissioner Oglesby moved that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Logan and passed unanimously.
