



EASEMENT AGREEMENT

THIS EASEMENT AGREEMENT (“Agreement”) is made and entered into as of the ____ day of _____, 20____, by and between **Fayette County, Tennessee**, having a mailing address of _____ (“**Grantor**”), and **Verizon Wireless Tennessee Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless**, with its principal office located at One Verizon Way, Mail Stop 4AW100, Basking Ridge, New Jersey 07920 (telephone number 866-862-4404) (“**Grantee**”). The Grantor and Grantee are at times collectively referred to hereinafter as the “**Parties**” or individually as the “**Party**”.

WHEREAS, Grantor is owner of certain real property located in Somerville, Fayette County, Tennessee, being more particularly described in **Exhibit A** attached hereto (“**Grantor's Property**”); and

WHEREAS, Grantee intends to operate telecommunications equipment on a water tank (“**Water Tank**”) owned by the Town of Somerville, Tennessee which Water Tank is located on property adjacent to Grantor's Property.

WHEREAS, Utility Service Communications Co, Inc. (“**USCC**”) currently manages the Water Tank for the Town of Somerville, Tennessee, and Grantee and USCC are in the process of negotiating an Agreement to allow Grantee to license a portion of the Water Tank and surrounding property owned by the Town of

Somerville, Tennessee (the “**Leased Premises**”) for the placement and operation of Grantee's telecommunications equipment (the “**Facility**”).

WHEREAS, Grantor wishes to grant to Grantee a non-exclusive easement, extending under and through the Grantor's Property, for the installation and maintenance of underground utility wires, fiber, cables, conduits, and pipes to serve the Facility (the “**Grantee's Improvements**”).

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which the Parties hereby acknowledge, Grantor agrees to grant a non-exclusive easement to Grantee upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Easement. Grantor hereby grants to, and for the benefit of, Grantee, its successors and assigns, a non-exclusive appurtenant easement under and through the Grantor's Property, as more particularly described in **Exhibit B** attached hereto and incorporated herein, for the installation and maintenance of Grantee's Improvements (the “**Easement**”). Grantor covenants and agrees that it will not build or install, and will not permit the building or installation of, any improvements of any kind in or on the Easement during the term of this Agreement. Grantor covenants not to do or permit any act or acts that unreasonably prevent or hinder Grantee's, its successors', agents', or assigns' use of the Easement for the aforementioned purposes.

2. Effective Date. The grant of the Easement shall be effective upon the full execution of this Agreement.

3. Term. This Agreement shall exist for only so long as Grantee, its successors or assigns, operate the Facility. This Agreement shall terminate automatically upon the removal of Grantee's Improvements from Grantor's Property.

4. Indemnification. Each Party shall indemnify, defend, and hold the other harmless against any third party claim of liability or loss from personal injury or property damage resulting from, or arising out of, the negligence or willful misconduct of the indemnifying Party, its employees, contractors or agents, except to the extent such claims or damages may be due to, or caused by, the negligence or willful misconduct of the other Party, or its employees, contractors, invitees, or agents.

5. Termination. At Grantee's option, Grantee may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice to Grantor for any reason, or no reason.

6. Title. Grantor represents and warrants to Grantee that Grantor has good and marketable title to the Grantor's Property, and may legally grant the Easement to Grantee.

7. Maintenance. Grantee shall maintain the Easement in a condition suitable for its use for the installation and maintenance of Grantee's Improvements, but not otherwise. During the term of this Agreement, Grantor will not give, grant, or convey any interest in, or license or permission to use, the Easement not already existing on the date of this Agreement, as such interests or uses may materially adversely affect or interfere with Grantee's use of the Easement. After completion of the installation of Grantee's Improvements, Grantee, at its expense, will restore the surface of the Easement to a condition reasonably similar to its condition prior to the installation of Grantee's Improvements. If the Easement is damaged or obstructed for any reason so as to render all or any part of the Easement substantially unusable for Grantee's intended use, then Grantee may terminate this Agreement, at Grantee's option, without further obligation from Grantee to Grantor.

8. Character of Easements. The covenants and provisions contained in this Agreement are made as an appurtenance for the benefit of the Leased Premises, create an equitable servitude upon the Grantor's Property, and are covenants running with the land.

9. Miscellaneous.

a. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between Grantor and Grantee. Any amendments to this Agreement must be in writing and executed by Grantor and Grantee.

b. Severability. If any provision of this Agreement is invalid or unenforceable with respect to any Party, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of such provision to persons other than those as to whom it is held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected, and each provision of this Agreement shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.

c. Due Authorization. Each Party hereby represents and warrants to the other that the person executing this Agreement on behalf of the warranting Party has the full right, power and authority to enter into, and execute, this Agreement on that Party's behalf, and that no consent from any other person or entity is necessary as a condition precedent to the legal effect of this Agreement.

d. Binding Agreement. This Agreement shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the successors and permitted assignees of the Parties.

e. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Tennessee.







Inmate with holds Ratio



- “The most common definition of crowding is when the jail population consistently exceeds design, or rated, capacity. However, symptoms of crowding may be apparent much earlier—once the jail reaches approximately 80 percent of rated capacity. At that level, properly housing and managing the diverse jail population begins to become much more difficult because compromises in the jail’s classification system occur.”
- “Compromising the jail’s classification capabilities is likely to lead to increases in violence, tension, and the availability of contraband. Basic functions (security, maintenance, sanitation, programs, recreation, etc.) begin to break down when they are stretched to their limit for extended periods of time due to crowding. These conditions increase the jail’s liability exposure and jeopardize the safety and well-being of both inmates and staff.”






